### **Priorities**

The Critical Labor Coalition (CLC) focused its targeted demographics and resulting 2023 legislative priorities to address the labor shortage on two issue areas: workforce growth and tax incentives. By working both individually and with strategic partners, CLC focused on the advancement of the following:

#### **Workforce Growth Initiatives**

- Essential Workers for Economic Advancement Act (H.R. 3734)
- Asylum Seeker Work Authorization Act (S. 255, H.R. 1325)
- Administrative efforts to streamline asylum processes

#### Tax Incentives

- EITC Age Parity Act (H.R. 5689)
- Improve and Enhance the Work Opportunity Tax Credit Act (H.R. 6833)

### Accomplishments

#### Introduction of EITC Age Parity Act (H.R. 5689)

Worked with AARP and Golden State Opportunity in support of bill introduction and addition of 10 cosponsors

Bipartisan introduction of Essential Workers for Economic Advancement Act (H.R. 3734) Supported the addition of Rep. Henry Cuellar as democratic lead for bill introduction

Bipartisan introduction of Improve and Enhance the Work Opportunity Tax Credit Act (H.R. 6833)

Lead organization in supporting bill introduction and bipartisan co-sponsorship

Increased bicameral co-sponsorship of Asylum Seeker Work Authorization Act (S.255, H.R. 1325)
